We, on behalf of humanity, serve to protect and hold those involved accountable for their crimes against humanity. Walking with us, you will be guided, protected, respected, and invited to learn our cultural Sovran ways, living with the land and Original Peoples of Kanat'an.

The recent Covid-19 vaccination mandates are presently revealing massive populations of injuries, and numerous losses of life of family members, at the hands of leaders who promised the vaccines to be safe, yet punishing those who would not comply. Intentional misinformation and removal of basic human rights and freedoms has caused more injuries.
